

1. Matthew 3:15, And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer *it to be so* now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him.

2. Matthew 4:17, From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

3. Matthew 4:19, And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.

4. Matthew 5:12, Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great *is* your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

5. Matthew 5:16, Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

6. Matthew 5:17, Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

7. Matthew 5:24, Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.

8. Matthew 5:25, Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison.

9. Matthew 5:29, And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast *it* from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not *that* thy whole body should be cast into hell.

10. Matthew 5:30, And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast *it* from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not *that* thy whole body should be cast into hell.

11. Matthew 5:34, But I say unto you, Swear not at all; neither by heaven; for it is God's throne:

12. Matthew 5:39, But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.

13. Matthew 5:40, And if any man will sue thee at the law, and take away thy coat, let him have *thy* cloke also.

14. Matthew 5:41, And whosoever shall compel thee to go a mile, go with him twain.

15. Matthew 5:42, Give to him that

asketh thee, and from him that would borrow of thee turn not thou away.

16. Matthew 5:44, But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

17. Matthew 5:48, Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

18. Matthew 6:1, Take heed that ye do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise ye have no reward of your Father which is in heaven.

19. Matthew 6:6, But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.

20. Matthew 6:7, But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen *do*: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.

21. Matthew 6:9, After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

22. Matthew 6:16, Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

23. Matthew 6:19, Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

24. Matthew 6:20, But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor

steal:

25. Matthew 6:25, Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?

26. Matthew 6:33, But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

27. Matthew 6:34, Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

28. Matthew 7:1, Judge not, that ye be not judged.

29. Matthew 7:5, Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye;

and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

30. Matthew 7:7, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

31. Matthew 7:12, Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

32. Matthew 7:13, Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, and broad *is* the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:

33. Matthew 7:15, Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

34. Matthew 7:23, And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you:

depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

35. Matthew 8:13, And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

36. Matthew 8:22, But Jesus said unto him, Follow me; and let the dead bury their dead.

37. Matthew 9:6, But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.

38. Matthew 9:9, And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.

39. Matthew 9:13, But go ye and learn

what *that* meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

40. Matthew 9:22, But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

41. Matthew 9:24, He said unto them, Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed him to scorn.

42. Matthew 9:29, Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.

43. Matthew 9:30, And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See *that* no man know *it*.

44. Matthew 9:38, Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send

forth labourers into his harvest.

45. Matthew 10:5, These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into *any* city of the Samaritans enter ye not:

46. Matthew 10:6, But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

47. Matthew 10:7, And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.

48. Matthew 10:8, Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

49. Matthew 10: 9, Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses,

50. Matthew 10:11, And into whatsoever city or town ye shall enter,

enquire who in it is worthy; and there abide till ye go thence.

51. Matthew 10:12, And when ye come into an house, salute it.

52. Matthew 10:13, And if the house be worthy, let your peace come upon it: but if it be not worthy, let your peace return to you.

53. Matthew 10:14, And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet.

54. Matthew 10:16, Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

55. Matthew 10:17, But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues;

56. Matthew 10:19, But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.

57. Matthew 10:23, But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of man be come.

58. Matthew 10:26, Fear them not therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known.

59. Matthew 10:27, What I tell you in darkness, *that* speak ye in light: and what ye hear in the ear, *that* preach ye upon the housetops.

60. Matthew 10:28, And fear not them which kill the body, but are not

able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

61. Matthew 10:31, Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows.

62. Matthew 10:34, Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.

63. Matthew 11:4, Jesus answered and said unto them, Go and shew John again those things which ye do hear and see:

64. Matthew 11:15, He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.

65. Matthew 11:28, Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

66. Matthew 11:29, Take my yoke

upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

67. Matthew 12:13, Then saith he to the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched *it* forth; and it was restored whole, like as the other.

68. Matthew 13:18, Hear ye therefore the parable of the sower.

69. Matthew 13:43, Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.

70. Matthew 14:27, But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.

71. Matthew 14:29, And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

72. Matthew 15:4, For God commanded, saying, Honour thy father and mother: and, He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death.

73. Matthew 15:10, And he called the multitude, and said unto them, Hear, and understand:

74. Matthew 16:6, Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

75. Matthew 16:20, Then charged he his disciples that they should tell no man that he was Jesus the Christ.

76. Matthew 17:27, Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of

money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.

77. Matthew 18:8, Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast *them* from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into everlasting fire.

78. Matthew 18:9, And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast *it* from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire.

79. Matthew 18:10, Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven.

80. Matthew 18:15, Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go

and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother.

81. Matthew 18:16, But if he will not hear *thee, then* take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.

82. Matthew 18:17, And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell *it* unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican.

83. Matthew 19:6, Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.

84. Matthew 19:14, But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven.

85. Matthew 19:17, And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? *there is* none good but one, *that is*, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.

86. Matthew 19:18, He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness,

87. Matthew 19:19, Honour thy father and *thy* mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

88. Matthew 19:21, Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go *and* sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come *and* follow me.

89. Matthew 21:2, Saying unto them, Go into the village over against you, and

straightway ye shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her: loose *them*, and bring *them* unto me.

90. Matthew 21:33, Hear another parable: There was a certain householder, which planted a vineyard, and hedged it round about, and digged a winepress in it, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country:

91. Matthew 22:19, Shew me the tribute money. And they brought unto him a penny.

92. Matthew 22:21, They say unto him, Caesar's. Then saith he unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's.

93. Matthew 22:37, Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul,

and with all thy mind.

94. Matthew 22:39, And the second *is* like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

95. Matthew 23:26, *Thou* blind Pharisee, cleanse first that *which is* within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also.

96. Matthew 23:32, Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers.

97. Matthew 24:4, And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.

98. Matthew 24:15, When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

99. Matthew 24:16, Then let them

which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:

100. Matthew 24:17, Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:

101. Matthew 24:18, Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.

102. Matthew 24:20, But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:

103. Matthew 24:23, Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here *is* Christ, or there; believe *it* not.

104. Matthew 24:26, Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, *he is* in the secret chambers; believe *it* not.

105. Matthew 24:32, Now learn a

parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer *is* nigh:

106. Matthew 24:42, Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.

107. Matthew 24:44, Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.

108. Matthew 25:13, Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.

109. Matthew 26:26, And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.

110. Matthew 26:27, And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to

them, saying, Drink ye all of it;

111. Matthew 26:36, Then cometh Jesus with them unto a place called Gethsemane, and saith unto the disciples, Sit ye here, while I go and pray yonder.

112. Matthew 26:38, Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me.

113. Matthew 26:41, Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

114. Matthew 26:45, Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take *your* rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.

115. Matthew 26:46, Rise, let us be going: behold, he is at hand that doth betray me.

116. Matthew 26:52, Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword.

117. Matthew 28:10, Then said Jesus unto them, Be not afraid: go tell my brethren that they go into Galilee, and there shall they see me.

118. Matthew 28:19, Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

119. Matthew 28:20, Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

120. Mark 1:15, And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

121. Mark 1:17, And Jesus said unto them, Come ye after me, and I will make you to become fishers of men.

122. Mark 2:11, I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house.

123. Mark 2:14, And as he passed by, he saw Levi the *son* of Alphaeus sitting at the receipt of custom, and said unto him, Follow me. And he arose and followed him.

124. Mark 3:3, And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, Stand forth.

125. Mark 3:5, And when he had looked round about on them with anger,

being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched *it* out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.

126. Mark 4:9, And he said unto them, He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.

127. Mark 4:23, If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.

128. Mark 5:19, Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee.

129. Mark 5:34, And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

130. Mark 5:36, As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he

saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only believe.

131. Mark 5:41, And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

132. Mark 6:10, And he said unto them, In what place soever ye enter into an house, there abide till ye depart from that place.

133. Mark 6:11, And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrhah in the day of judgment, than for that city.

134. Mark 6:37, He answered and said unto them, Give ye them to eat. And they say unto him, Shall we go and buy two hundred pennyworth of bread, and

give them to eat?

135. Mark 6:39, And he commanded them to make all sit down by companies upon the green grass.

136. Mark 6:50, For they all saw him, and were troubled. And immediately he talked with them, and saith unto them, Be of good cheer: it is I; be not afraid.

137. Mark 7:14, And when he had called all the people *unto him*, he said unto them, Hearken unto me every one *of you*, and understand:

138. Mark 7:16, If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.

139. Mark 7:34, And looking up to heaven, he sighed, and saith unto him, Ephphatha, that is, Be opened.

140. Mark 7:36, And he charged them that they should tell no man: but

the more he charged them, so much the more a great deal they published *it*;

141. Mark 8:6, And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before *them*; and they did set *them* before the people.

142. Mark 8:15, And he charged them, saying, Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and *of* the leaven of Herod.

143. Mark 8:26, And he sent him away to his house, saying, Neither go into the town, nor tell *it* to any in the town.

144. Mark 8:30, And he charged them that they should tell no man of him.

145. Mark 8:33, But when he had

turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

146. Mark 9:39, But Jesus said, Forbid him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle in my name, that can lightly speak evil of me.

147. Mark 9:43, And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:

148. Mark 9:45, And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:

149. Mark 9:47, And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for

thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire:

150. Mark 9:50, Salt *is* good: but if the salt have lost his saltness, wherewith will ye season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace one with another.

151. Mark 10:19, Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

152. Mark 10:21, Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.

153. Mark 10:49, And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called.

And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; he calleth thee.

154. Mark 11:2, And saith unto them, Go your way into the village over against you: and as soon as ye be entered into it, ye shall find a colt tied, whereon never man sat; loose him, and bring *him*.

155. Mark 11:3, And if any man say unto you, Why do ye this? say ye that the Lord hath need of him; and straightway he will send him hither.

156. Mark 11:22, And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

157. Mark 11:24, Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive *them*, and ye shall have *them*.

158. Mark 11:25, And when ye stand

praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

159. Mark 12:15, Shall we give, or shall we not give? But he, knowing their hypocrisy, said unto them, Why tempt ye me? bring me a penny, that I may see *it*.

160. Mark 12:17, And Jesus answering said unto them, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's. And they marvelled at him.

161. Mark 12:30, And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this *is* the first commandment.

162. Mark 12:31, And the second *is* like, *namely* this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

163. Mark 12:38, And he said unto them in his doctrine, Beware of the scribes, which love to go in long clothing, and *love* salutations in the marketplaces,

164. Mark 13:5, And Jesus answering them began to say, Take heed lest any *man* deceive you:

165. Mark 13:7, And when ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars, be ye not troubled: for *such things* must needs be; but the end *shall not be* yet.

166. Mark 13:9, But take heed to yourselves: for they shall deliver you up to councils; and in the synagogues ye shall be beaten: and ye shall be brought before rulers and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them.

167. Mark 13:11, But when they shall lead *you*, and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak,

neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost.

168. Mark 13:14, But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:

169. Mark 13:15, And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter *therein*, to take any thing out of his house:

170. Mark 13:18, And pray ye that your flight be not in the winter.

171. Mark 13:23, But take ye heed: behold, I have foretold you all things.

172. Mark 13:29, So ye in like manner, when ye shall see these things

come to pass, know that it is nigh, *even* at the doors.

173. Mark 13:33, Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is.

174. Mark 13:35, Watch ye therefore: for ye know not when the master of the house cometh, at even, or at midnight, or at the cockcrowing, or in the morning:

175. Mark 13:37, And what I say unto you I say unto all, Watch.

176. Mark 14:6, And Jesus said, Let her alone; why trouble ye her? she hath wrought a good work on me.

177. Mark 14:13, And he sendeth forth two of his disciples, and saith unto them, Go ye into the city, and there shall meet you a man bearing a pitcher of water: follow him.

178. Mark 14:14, And wheresoever he shall go in, say ye to the goodman of the house, The Master saith, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?

179. Mark 14:15, And he will shew you a large upper room furnished *and* prepared: there make ready for us.

180. Mark 14:22, And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake *it*, and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body.

181. Mark 14:32, And they came to a place which was named Gethsemane: and he saith to his disciples, Sit ye here, while I shall pray.

182. Mark 14:34, And saith unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful unto death: tarry ye here, and watch.

183. Mark 14:38, Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly *is* ready, but the flesh *is* weak.

184. Mark 14:41, And he cometh the third time, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take *your* rest: it is enough, the hour is come; behold, the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.

185. Mark 14:42, Rise up, let us go; lo, he that betrayeth me is at hand.

186. Mark 16:6, And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: he is risen; he is not here: behold the place where they laid him.

187. Mark 16:7, But go your way, tell his disciples and Peter that he goeth before you into Galilee: there shall ye see him, as he said unto you.

188. Mark 16:15, And he said unto

them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

189. Luke 5:4, Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught.

190. Luke 5:10, And so *was* also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.

191. Luke 5:13, And he put forth *his* hand, and touched him, saying, I will: be thou clean. And immediately the leprosy departed from him.

192. Luke 5:14, And he charged him to tell no man: but go, and shew thyself to the priest, and offer for thy cleansing, according as Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.

193. Luke 5:24, But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (he said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.

194. Luke 5:27, And after these things he went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, Follow me.

195. Luke 6:8, But he knew their thoughts, and said to the man which had the withered hand, Rise up, and stand forth in the midst. And he arose and stood forth.

196. Luke 6:10, And looking round about upon them all, he said unto the man, Stretch forth thy hand. And he did so: and his hand was restored whole as the other.

197. Luke 6:23, Rejoice ye in that day, and leap for joy: for, behold, your reward *is* great in heaven: for in the like manner did their fathers unto the prophets.

198. Luke 6:27, But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which hate you,

199. Luke 6:28, Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.

200. Luke 6:29, And unto him that smiteth thee on the *one* cheek offer also the other; and him that taketh away thy cloke forbid not *to take thy* coat also.

201. Luke 6:30, Give to every man that asketh of thee; and of him that taketh away thy goods ask *them* not again.

202. Luke 6:31, And as ye would

that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise.

203. Luke 6:35, But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and *to* the evil.

204. Luke 6:36, Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful.

205. Luke 6:37, Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:

206. Luke 6:38, Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

207. Luke 7:13, And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not.

208. Luke 7:14, And he came and touched the bier: and they that bare *him* stood still. And he said, Young man, I say unto thee, Arise.

209. Luke 7:22, Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.

210. Luke 7:50, And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

211. Luke 8:18, Take heed therefore how ye hear: for whosoever hath, to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not, from him shall be

taken even that which he seemeth to have.

212. Luke 8:39, Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him.

213. Luke 8:48, And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.

214. Luke 8:50, But when Jesus heard *it*, he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.

215. Luke 8:52, And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth.

216. Luke 8:54, And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and

called, saying, Maid, arise.

217. Luke 9:3, And he said unto them, Take nothing for *your* journey, neither staves, nor scrip, neither bread, neither money; neither have two coats apiece.

218. Luke 9:4, And whatsoever house ye enter into, there abide, and thence depart.

219. Luke 9:5, And whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them.

220. Luke 9:13, But he said unto them, Give ye them to eat. And they said, We have no more but five loaves and two fishes; except we should go and buy meat for all this people.

221. Luke 9:14, For they were about five thousand men. And he said to his disciples, Make them sit down by fifties

in a company.

222. Luke 9:21, And he straitly charged them, and commanded *them* to tell no man that thing;

223. Luke 9:41, And Jesus answering said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you, and suffer you? Bring thy son hither.

224. Luke 9:50, And Jesus said unto him, Forbid *him* not: for he that is not against us is for us.

225. Luke 9:60, Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God.

226. Luke 10:2, Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly *is* great, but the labourers *are* few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.

227. Luke 10:3, Go your ways:
behold, I send you forth as lambs among
wolves.

228. Luke 10:4, Carry neither purse,
nor scrip, nor shoes: and salute no man
by the way.

229. Luke 10:5, And into whatsoever
house ye enter, first say, Peace *be* to this
house.

230. Luke 10:7, And in the same
house remain, eating and drinking such
things as they give: for the labourer is
worthy of his hire. Go not from house to
house.

231. Luke 10:9, And heal the sick that
are therein, and say unto them, The
kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.

232. Luke 10:10, But into
whatsoever city ye enter, and they
receive you not, go your ways out into

the streets of the same, and say,

233. Luke 10:20, Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

234. Luke 10:37, And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.

235. Luke 11:9, And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.

236. Luke 11:35, Take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not darkness.

237. Luke 11:41, But rather give alms of such things as ye have; and, behold, all things are clean unto you.

238. Luke 11:42, But woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass over judgment and the love of God: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

239. Luke 12:1, In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.

240. Luke 12:4, And I say unto you my friends, Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do.

241. Luke 12:5, But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast

into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him.

242. Luke 12:7, But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows.

243. Luke 12:11, And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and *unto* magistrates, and powers, take ye no thought how or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say:

244. Luke 12:15, And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.

245. Luke 12:22, And he said unto his disciples, Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat; neither for the body, what ye shall put on.

246. Luke 12:29, And seek not ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful mind.

247. Luke 12:31, But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you.

248. Luke 12:32, Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

249. Luke 12:33, Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth.

250. Luke 12:40, Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not.

251. Luke 13: 24, Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be

able.

252. Luke 13:32, And he said unto them, Go ye, and tell that fox, Behold, I cast out devils, and I do cures to day and to morrow, and the third *day* I shall be perfected.

253. Luke 14:8, When thou art bidden of any *man* to a wedding, sit not down in the highest room; lest a more honourable man than thou be bidden of him;

254. Luke 14:10, But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee.

255. Luke 14:12, Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends,

nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor *thy* rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompence be made thee.

256. Luke 14:13, But when thou makest a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind:

257. Luke 14:23, And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel *them* to come in, that my house may be filled.

258. Luke 17:14, And when he saw *them*, he said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed.

259. Luke 17:19, And he said unto him, Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole.

260. Luke 17:23, And they shall say to

you, See here; or, see there: go not after *them*, nor follow *them*.

261. Luke 17:31, In that day, he which shall be upon the housetop, and his stuff in the house, let him not come down to take it away: and he that is in the field, let him likewise not return back.

262. Luke 17:32, Remember Lot's wife.

263. Luke 18:1, And he spake a parable unto them *to this end*, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;

264. Luke 18:6, And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith.

265. Luke 18:16, But Jesus called them *unto him*, and said, Suffer little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.

266. Luke 18:20, Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother.

267. Luke 18:22, Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me.

268. Luke 18:40, And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto him: and when he was come near, he asked him,

269. Luke 18:42, And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee.

270. Luke 19:5, And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up, and

saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for to day I must abide at thy house.

271. Luke 19:13, And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.

272. Luke 19:30, Saying, Go ye into the village over against *you*; in the which at your entering ye shall find a colt tied, whereon yet never man sat: loose him, and bring *him hither*.

273. Luke 19:31, And if any man ask you, Why do ye loose *him*? thus shall ye say unto him, Because the Lord hath need of him.

274. Luke 20:24, Shew me a penny. Whose image and superscription hath it? They answered and said, Ceasar's.

275. Luke 20:25, And he said unto

them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's.

276. Luke 20:46, Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts;

277. Luke 21:8, And he said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am *Christ*; and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them.

278. Luke 21:14, Settle *it* therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer:

279. Luke 21:19, In your patience possess ye your souls.

280. Luke 21:20, And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies,

then know that the desolation thereof is nigh.

281. Luke 21:21, Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto.

282. Luke 21:28, And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.

283. Luke 21:29, And he spake to them a parable; Behold the fig tree, and all the trees;

284. Luke 21:31, So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the kingdom of God is nigh at hand.

285. Luke 21:36, Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be

accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

286. Luke 22:8, And he sent Peter and John, saying, Go and prepare us the passover, that we may eat.

287. Luke 22:17, And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide *it* among yourselves:

288. Luke 22:19, And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

289. Luke 22:36, Then said he unto them, But now, he that hath a purse, let him take *it*, and likewise *his* scrip: and he that hath no sword, let him sell his garment, and buy one.

290. Luke 22:46, And said unto them,

Why sleep ye? rise and pray, lest ye enter into temptation.

291. Luke 22:51, And Jesus answered and said, Suffer ye thus far. And he touched his ear, and healed him.

292. Luke 24:39, Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.

293. Luke 24:49, And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

294. John 1:39, He saith unto them, Come and see. They came and saw where he dwelt, and abode with him that day: for it was about the tenth hour.

295. John 1:43, The day following Jesus would go forth into Galilee, and findeth Philip, and saith unto him, Follow

me.

296. John 2:7, Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.

297. John 2:8, And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare *it*.

298. John 2:16, And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not my Father's house an house of merchandise.

299. John 3:7, Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

300. John 4:7, There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink.

301. John 4:16, Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither.

302. John 4:35, Say not ye, There are yet four months, and *then* cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

303. John 4:50, Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way.

304. John 5:8, Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.

305. John 5:14, Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.

306. John 6:10, And Jesus said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

307. John 6:12, When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost.

308. John 6:20, But he saith unto them, It is I; be not afraid.

309. John 6:43, Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, Murmur not among yourselves.

310. John 7:8, Go ye up unto this feast: I go not up yet unto this feast; for my time is not yet full come.

311. John 8:7, So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.

312. John 8:11, She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

313. John 9:7, And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

314. John 11:39, Jesus said, Take ye away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been *dead* four days.

315. John 11:43, And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.

316. John 11:44, And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

317. John 12:7, Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.

318. John 14:11, Believe me that I *am* in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

319. John 14:15, If ye love me, keep my commandments.

320. John 14:31, But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence.

321. John 15:4, Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

322. John 15:12, This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.

323. John 15:17, These things I command you, that ye love one another.

324. John 15:20, Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.

325. John 18:21, Why askest thou me? ask them which heard me, what I have said unto them: behold, they know what I said.

326. John 19:26, When Jesus therefore saw his mother, and the disciple standing by, whom he loved, he saith unto his mother, Woman, behold thy son!

327. John 19:27, Then saith he to the disciple, Behold thy mother! And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own *home*.

328. John 20:17, Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended

to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and *to* my God, and your God.

329. John 20:22, And when he had said this, he breathed on *them*, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:

330. John 21:10, Jesus saith unto them, Bring of the fish which ye have now caught.

331. John 21:12, Jesus saith unto them, Come *and* dine. And none of the disciples durst ask him, Who art thou? knowing that it was the Lord.

332. John 21:15, So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.

333. John 21:16, He saith to him again the second time, Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

334. John 21:17, He saith unto him the third time, Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

335. John 21:22, Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what *is that* to thee? follow thou me.

336. Acts 1:4, And, being assembled together with *them*, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, *saith he*, ye have heard of me.
